Projects ranging from an airport inspection facility to the Shelter Island boat launch represent some of the most innovative and outstanding quality merit shop work in the region and were recognized Friday night at the annual Associated Builders and Contractors Excellence in Construction Awards. With a crowd of nearly 1,000 at the Hyatt Aventine, ABC recognized the men, women and projects who demonstrate quality construction through safety, teamwork and cooperation.
