
GENERAL INFORMATION

There are 6 Levels of STEP Achievement: Participant, Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum, and Diamond.

1. Visit www.abc.org/STEPapp to apply online today

STEP applications are accepted throughout the year until **October 1st** to ensure distribution of STEP certificates and achievement recognition at ABC SD's Excellence in Construction Awards.

2. The application consists of the following sections:

Section 1: Company Information

Section 2: Safety Performance Data

*All applicants MUST include a copy of their 2016 OSHA Form 300A with application.

Section 3: 20 Key Components of Safety Self-Assessment

Section 4: Company and ABC Chapter Certification

3. Notification of Application Completion - Upon submission, all applicants will be notified instantly of their provisional STEP level upon submitting all required information and final notification will occur when the STEP award is presented to the applicant upon review and confirmation of data by ABC National.
